

Rules

- 1. Dodgeball is a gentlemen's game, self-refereed and played with the honor rules!
- 2. There are referees stationed at the centerline that help start the game, confirm hits and catches and count ball possession time. Dodgeball is played with 6 balls, split into 2 even groups at the edge of the centerline. At opening rush you may only grab the balls to your right. This is a co-ed tournament, all teams MUST start with two women on the court. If this rule cannot be followed, the team must start two men down.
- 3. The referee's word is FINAL. No further discussion is needed. Referee's word is FINAL.
- 4. You are out if: You step over a side or centerline, a thrown live ball hits your body or you throw a live ball it is caught by an opponent. If the ball hits the floor before hitting you YOU ARE NOT OUT.
- 5. A thrown live ball can only hit out ONE player. Thrown balls that hit other objects before they hit the opponent are considered dead balls. (This includes the floor.)
- 6. You may block a thrown ball with a held ball. However if you drop the blocking ball during the act of blocking or if you fail to make a clean block and the balls hits or grazes your body. You are OUT.
- 7. If you are out, line up on the side in order of getting out, next to the referee (the resurrection line). If your teammate catches a ball the player at the start of your team's resurrection line comes back into play.
- 8. NO HEADSHOTS. And if you DO throw a headshot, please apologize to your opponent.
- 9. Once victories and losses are entered into the bracket, they are FINAL.
- 10. Have fun, shake hands, make friends and be spirited.
