Total Served: 1,752

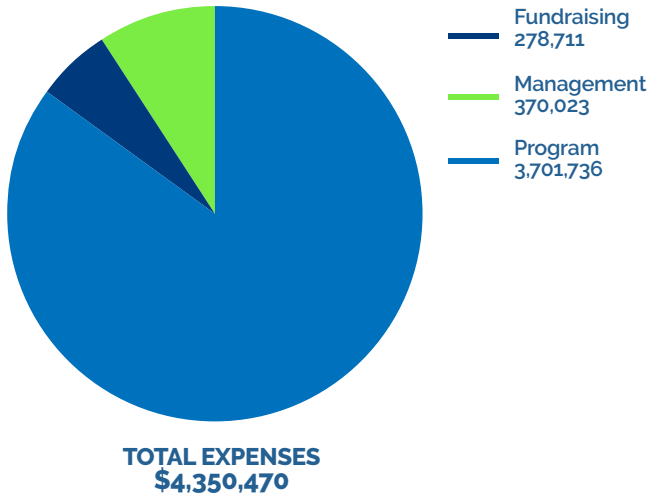
• Maternity Care

Serves mothers age 12-21 through a crisis shelter and transitional living program that includes teaching parenting skills and supporting educational and career goals

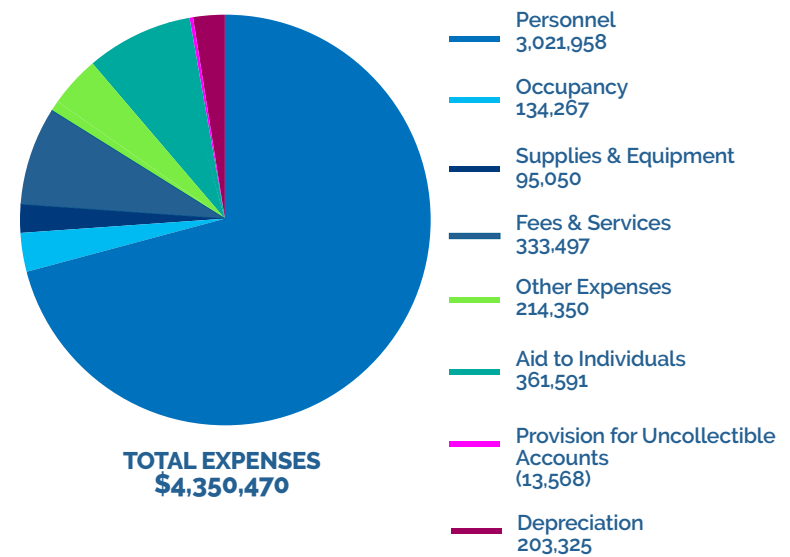
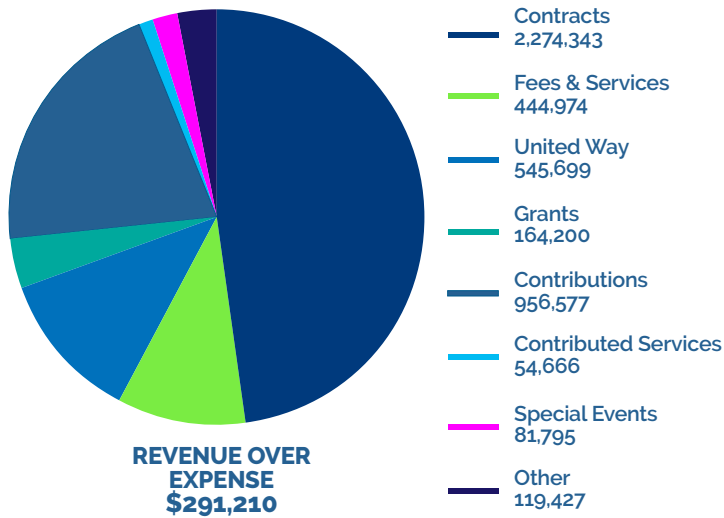
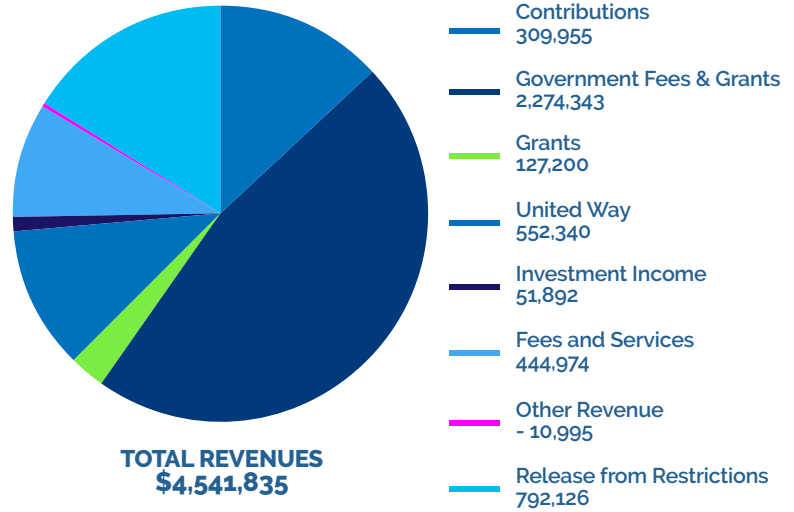
