We were married in 2016 and both wanted children right away. After 2 years of trying to become pregnant we spoke with our doctor, and she referred us to a fertility specialist where we were told we had less than a 5 percent chance every month to conceive a child. In 2018 we became pregnant, and we were very excited to start a family but at the first doctor's appointment we received the horrible news that we had miscarried. We decided to try again and became pregnant 7 months later in 2019. The first ultrasound revealed our baby was 7 weeks and the doctor could see the heartbeat. We were over the moon excited! Our doctor requested we come back in three weeks for a second ultrasound and when we returned, we received the devastating news that our baby no longer had a heartbeat. We went through a painful and difficult time of grief. After we allowed time to grieve, we healed through the support from our family, friends and prayer. That experience made our relationship stronger and closer than ever and after taking some time to reflect, we knew that we wanted to become parents more than anything and began our adoption journey.
