Job Description: Do you have a heart for moms, babies and children? Good Shepherd Children & Family Services is looking for a caring, dedicated Therapist to join our Maternity Shelter & Transitional Living Program, which provides intensive, 24-hour care for teen and young adult moms and their babies facing homelessness, and our Foster Care program. Good Shepherd offers a generous benefit package and competitive compensation, based upon experience. Under the direction of the Director of Treatment Services, the therapist provides clinical services including individual, family, and group therapy to support the programming at Good Shepherd. The therapist will maintain a minimum of 20 billable hours weekly, working with moms and babies in the Maternity Shelter, kids and families in foster care, and clients in adoption services. The therapist will be an integral part of the treatment team, and consult with internal and external team members to coordinate effective interventions and promote safety and progress. A minimum of two evenings may be required weekly in order accommodate scheduling and client availability, with some after-hours crisis intervention as needed. Sessions preferred in the client home or office, with occasional remote option. This position provides all services in accordance with the teachings of the Catholic Church.
