Foster Care Case Manager – Farmington, MO

Job Description:

The Foster Care Case Manager position is full time and serves St. Francis County. This position works cooperatively with MO Children's Division to serve children and families encountering the child welfare system and/or impacted by foster care placement. Primary responsibilities include providing assessment, service planning and case management to families with a focus on connecting children with families and keeping families connected. Job responsibilities including advocating for children and families within the systems impacting service delivery (i.e., educational, legal, medical, mental health systems) and conducting activities in a manner to facilitate the fundamental goals of the program: permanency for children, placement stability, safety of children and eliminate the need for congregate care. All activities related to case management must be documented in the state information system in a timely manner.

Qualifications:

This position requires strong written and verbal communication skills, an ability to work with a diverse client population, a desire to work as part of a team, a sense of humor, a working knowledge of community resources and a passion for the right of every child to be part of a permanent, loving family. Minimum requirements include at least a Bachelor's or Master's degree in social work, psychology, or counseling and 2 years child welfare experience. Prior Child Welfare Practice training preferred.
