Job Description:	The therapist provides clinical services including individual, family, and group therapy to support the foster care programming at Good Shepherd. The therapist will maintain a minimum of 20 - 25 billable hours weekly, working with youth in the Treatment Foster Care program as well as children/youth in the foster care system as needed. The therapist will be provided clinical supervision from an LPC level supervisor and will be an integral part of the treatment foster care team consulting with internal and external team members to coordinate effective interventions and promote safety and progress. A minimum of two evenings may be required weekly in order accommodate scheduling and client availability, with some after-hours crisis intervention as needed. Sessions will be offered primarily in the youth's foster home in the community with office sessions available if needed.  This position will serve St. Louis City, St. Louis County and adjacent counties and requires travel within those communities as most sessions will take place in the child's foster home.  This position provides all services in accordance with the teachings of the Catholic Church.
Qualifications:	<ul> <li>Master's degree in Counseling, Psychology, Social Work or a closely related field is required.</li> <li>Current, unrestricted clinical licensure or provisional licensure.</li> <li>An authorized service provider under Missouri Medicaid or the ability to become so within 90 days of employment.</li> <li>2 years post-Masters experience in providing mental health therapy to emotionally disturbed youth or a similarly challenging population preferred but not required. New graduates are encouraged to apply and will be provided clinical supervision as a benefit of employment!</li> </ul>
