• ADOPTION

Good Shepherd finds safe, loving, adoptive homes for children and provides a full array of adoption services to families. Our guiding principle is that adoption is a life-giving alternative to abortion.

• FOSTER CARE / TREATMENT F.C.

Good Shepherd helps children in moments of crisis find families with room in their homes and hearts, including those who have struggled in a traditional setting and need an extra layer of therapeutic support.

• PREGNANCY & PARENTING SUPPORT

> Pregnancy Resource Centers

Good Shepherd runs three pregnancy resource centers which provide community-based services for pregnant women including pregnant teens, crisis counseling, and connections to community resources.

> Shelter

Good Shepherd serves mothers age 12-21 through a crisis shelter and transitional living program that includes teaching parenting skills and supporting educational and career goals.

> In-Home

Good Shepherd ensures healthy infants and families by going out into the community and providing counseling, resources, and assistance to expectant mothers in crisis.

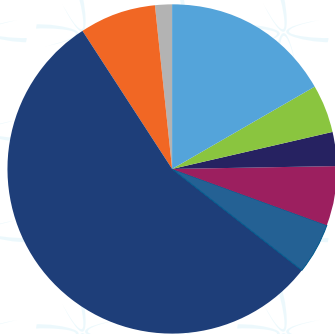

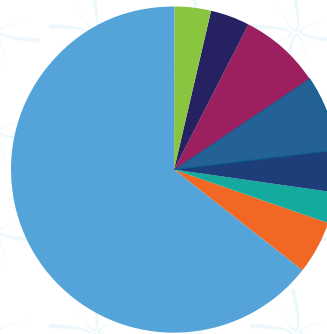
FY22 TOTAL REVENUES

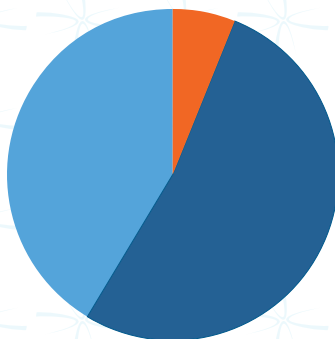
FY22 TOTAL EXPENSES
